YARD AND GARDEN WASTE PICK-UP

Village employees will pick up, at the curb, yard and garden waste that is:

1. Bagged and/or
2. Bundled and tied.
3. No longer than 3 feet.
4. **Weighs no more than 40 lbs.**
5. If it isn't yard or garden waste it won't be picked up.
6. Please keep leaves and twigs separate.
7. **DO NOT PLACE PLASTIC, METALS, OR ANYTHING BESIDES YARD WASTE IN THE BAGS.**

The dump site is very specific about what can or cannot be placed in the fill.
